#### F4C and F4H scale world championships Switzerland

#### <u>5<sup>th</sup> Jul – 14<sup>th</sup> 2018</u>

We had a team of six entrants from Australia head to the FAI scale world championships in Switzerland earlier this month. 4 team members were from Melbourne David Law, Greg Lepp, Noel Whitehead (all YVA members) and Noel Findlay from Ballarat. Two from NSW were Pete

Goff and Anthony Ogle. With six entrants Australia had a full team with three in F4C (scratch built) class and three in F4H. It was a first for Greg Lepp and Pete Goff to compete and both did an outstanding job with both achieving top scores within a round of F4H class. In F4H Australia placed fourth out of twelve countries which is an excellent result being the first international scale competition that Greg and Pete had competed in combined with Anthony who competed two years ago. In F4C Australia came first winning a gold medal which is an

outstanding achievement and even more so to do it half way around the world in Switzerland. The team should be very proud of their achievements and will be remembered permanently in the history books of the scale world championships.
